What Does MINTS Stand For?

- M- Months, Days, Holidays (Halloween, Christmas, July)
- I- The pronoun I
- N- Names of people, places, etc (Chick-Fil-A, Peter)
- T- Titles of books, movies, magazines
- S- Start of Sentences

Examples

- Ms. bridges went to target on monday and bought clothes.
- Rewrite correctly: Ms. Bridges went to Target on Monday and bought clothes.
