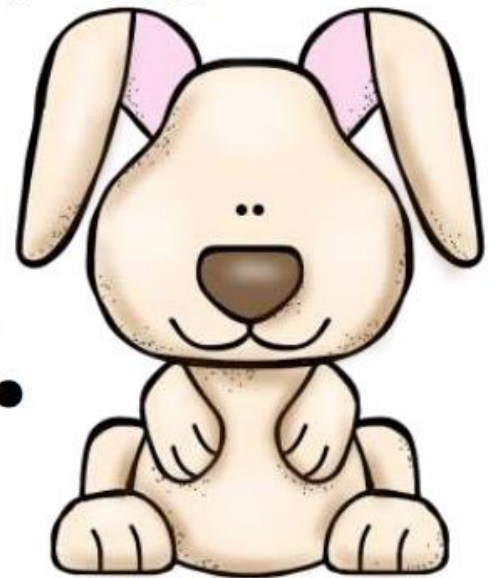


Figurative Language

Simile

TO COMPARE TWO THINGS USING
THE WORDS LIKE OR AS

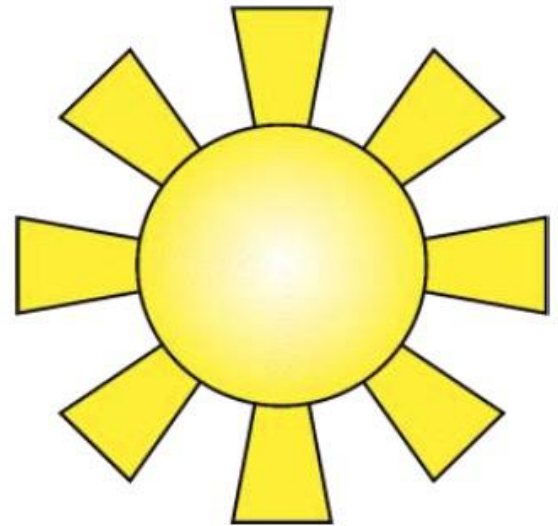
**He is as fast
as a rabbit.**



Metaphor

TO COMPARE TWO THINGS USING
THE WORDS IS OR ARE

**Her smile
is the sun.**



Personification

To describe non-human things
using human qualities

**The leaves danced
in the wind.**



Alliteration

A sentence or phrase with
words that start with the same
letter or sound

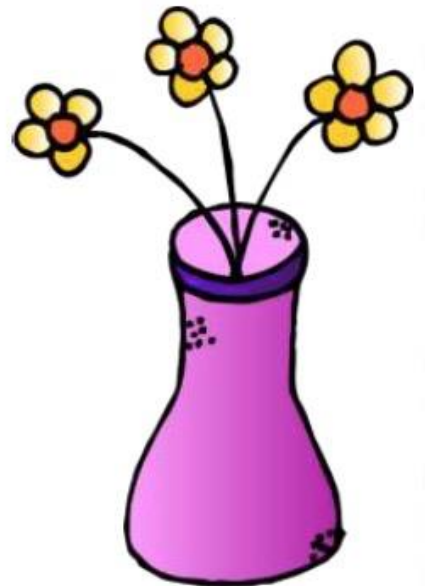
**Morgan Mouse munched
marshmallows merrily.**



Onomatopoeia

A word that sounds like the
noise it makes

**The dog knocked
over the vase with
a *crash*!**



Idiom

Phrases that mean something different than what they say

**It's raining
cats and dogs.**



Hyperbole

TO describe something in an
extremely exaggerated way

**We waited in
line all day.**
